WEB SITE

As planned, we are proceeding with the migration of our website to a WordPress platform rather than migrate to the newest version of our current platform Joomla, due to it requiring rewriting most of our web content. WordPress is a more popular platform and it's much easier to find support for WordPress. We are reviewing the draft statement of work and costs submitted by our consultant Charlie Engel. There is one issue that we want to bring to your attention. Currently, all users, when accessing the N&V and Committee reports see a drop down screen giving them access to all years in the data base (currently twelve years and counting.) The migration plan submitted by Charlie calls for the drop down screen giving access to the most current five (5) years. The data for all years will be in the database but most users would only get to access 5 years. Additional costs would be required if we want to give all users access to documents beyond the five years provided in the conversion plan.
