BOARD BRIEFS

The MTHOA Board approved \$350.00 for tree removal @ 100 Cricket Court, \$636.83 the balance payment for replacement street signs and \$500.00 toward the price of digging another landfill at Hardee Maintenance for Myrtle Trace yard debris.

The Myrtle Trace Activities Committee has revisited their Guidelines for Hosting an Activity: #5 section c #8 Refund Policy will remain the same (Refunds will be given upon request.)

We have decided, beginning immediately, to lift the mask mandate and surface cleaning and make it optional but recommended for the Clubhouse and the pool. 50 Myrtle Trace Residents ONLY is still in effect for both the Clubhouse and the pool. You must follow the Clubhouse guidelines. This means a limit of 50 people (MT residents only), wearing of a mask is optional, social distance (6' apart), sanitizing all surfaces is optional, and no sharing food or drink. We will continue to revisit the restrictions on a month to month basis and take actions that are appropriate regarding the COVID-19 positive progress.

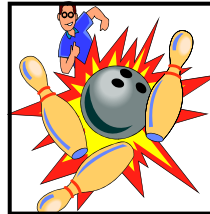
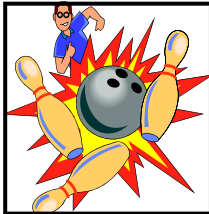

ATTENTION BRIDGE PLAYERS

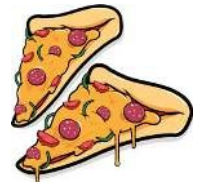
